# **Ongoing Formation 2020 Program Proposal**

Version: Initial draft for Advisory Committee review

## SUMMARY:

Given the in-person interaction limitations in place due to COVID-19, the original proposal of bringing in quarterly speakers and streaming to local-led group sessions has been postponed. The following proposals outline three options that can address ongoing formation needs during this immediate term. The objectives for all three programs are as follows:

- Increase awareness of available and recommended resources
- Enable communications and interaction across communities
- Provide support and learning for members

## **PROGRAMS:**

## **Ongoing Formation Roundtable Calls**

Description: 90-minute monthly video conference calls facilitated and led by Lyn Korte open to all members from WRC member communities

Structure:

- 1. Lead with deep dive into one posted resource led by volunteer presenter, followed by open discussion
- 2. Introduce new resources posted on WRC website
- 3. Call for new/additional resources and topics

## Book Club/Discussion Groups for Community Members

Description: 90-minute bimonthly in-depth video conference discussion on pre-specified reading or video led by volunteer, open to all members from WRC member communities.

Structure:

- 1. Identify reading or video assignment
- 2. Seek volunteer to prepare question/discussion guide
- 3. Post designated reading or video and discussion guide on WRC website with call details
- 4. Volunteer leads call using discussion guide for open participation

#### **Book Club/Discussion Groups for Leaders**

Description: 90-minute bimonthly in -depth video conference discussion on pre-specified reading or video led by volunteer, open to leaders of WRC member communities and to LCWR network. (Consider LCWR newsletter for content and content leaders.)

Structure:

- 1. Identify reading or video assignment
- 2. Seek volunteer to prepare question/discussion guide
- 3. Post designated reading or video and discussion guide on WRC website with call details
- 4. Volunteer leads call using discussion guide for open participation

#### **TOPICS:**

During our previous call, we had highlighted grieving/loss/change and community living and discussed building the topics in conjunction with the liturgical calendar. Of course, now, we can add angles related to quarantine, safer at home, social distancing, etc.
